[Amon Carter Museum](#)




The Amon Carter Museum is known for its unsurpassed compilation of American art. Discover works by early 19th Century artist-explorers, mid-20th Century modernists, and contemporary photographers. What's more, the museum is home to one of the most complete collections of work by Charles M. Russell and Frederic Remington. This museum is named for Amon G. Carter, one of Fort Worth's leading citizens who bequeathed funds for its establishment.

[Fort Worth Museum of Science and Industry](#)

The Fort Worth Museum of Science and History opened in 1945 as the Fort Worth Children's Museum and moved to its current location in 1954. In 1968, the museum adopted its current name. Attractions at the museum include the Noble Planetarium and the Omni Theater, in addition to both traveling and permanent science and history exhibits. In the fall of 2007, the museum was closed for renovations. The entire museum was moved into a new building at the same site in 2009. The new building, was designed by architects Legorreta + Legorreta with Gideon Toal and consists of 166,000 square feet. Although its name, location, size, and scope have changed dramatically since 1941, the Museum still serves a similar purpose: to provide an extraordinary learning environment to the community.

The Kimbell Art Museum's permanent collection, which covers ancient times to the 20th Century, is small in number (350) but large in quality. Visitors will enjoy masterpieces by Caravaggio, Poussin, Velázquez, Rembrandt, Goya, Monet, Cézanne, Picasso, and Matisse. Amazing antiquities cover the period from the Egyptian Old Kingdom of the third millennium B.C. to the Early Christian Church in the 5th Century. Beginning September 26, 2009 Michelangelo's first known painting, "The Torment of Saint Anthony" will be on view among the


permanent collection of the Kimbell Art Museum. In addition there is a fine arrange of Asian, African and Pre-Columbian art.

The Modern Art Museum of Fort Worth is renowned for its displays of post-World War II art in a wide range of media. Home to one of the leading collections of contemporary art in the central U.S., The Modern's permanent collection features over 3,000 works from artists as varied as Robert Motherwell, Pablo Picasso, Jackson Pollock, Susan Rothenberg, Richard Serra, Gerhard Richter, Andy Warhol, and Cindy Sherman. This one-of-a-kind museum opened its doors in Hereford, Texas in 1975 to preserve and explain the incredible history of the American cowgirl. Since 2002, the museum has been housed in a new building in Fort Worth, Texas. Learn about the women whose contributions shaped the American West via interactive exhibits featuring artifacts and photographs, a traveling exhibit gallery, and an expansive research library. Visit the National Cowgirl Hall of Fame where you'll encounter the stories of nearly 200 female inductees, including artists,

writers, entertainers, pioneers, competitive performers, and trailblazers, from the mid-1800s to the present day.
