



The Prague Castle is the most significant Czech monument and one of the most important cultural institutions in the Czech Republic.

According to the Guinness Book of World Records, the Prague Castle is the largest complex in the world, with an area of almost 70,000 m². Prague Castle is part of UNESCO World Heritage site, because of large composition of palaces and religious buildings in the various architectures, from the 10th century Roman-style buildings to Gothic modifications in the 14th century. In the time of the First Republic (1918-1938) the most famous Slovenian architect Josip Plečnik was responsible for extensive renovation.
