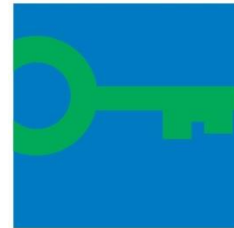


WE CARE ABOUT OUR Environment

Hilton Stockholm Slussen has for a long time been in the foreground regarding environmental initiatives and we are sorting waste in 23 different fractions and purchase electricity from only water and wind-power and much more. We are Green Key certified since May 2017.

Making a business environmentally friendly is a constant process and one in which we are all involved. Hilton Stockholm Slussen adopts a long term approach to ensure the operations work in balance with cycles of nature through constant, ongoing environmental work. This includes education about sustainability for our team members, environmental information and increased awareness for both our team members and our guest. Our ambition is to constantly better our yearly environmental objectives, which are measure and supervised.

Green Key

Hilton Stockholm Slussen has been awarded with the International eco-label Green Key. We continuously strive towards reducing our environmental footprint and to improve our social responsibility. By staying at a Green key establishment, you are helping to create a more sustainable society.

What is Green Key?

The Green Key award is the leading standard for excellence in the field of environmental responsibility and sustainable operation with the tourism industry. Awarded establishments must fulfil various Green Key criteria, formulate an environmental/sustainability policy and work with constant improvements through annual goals and action plans. To guarantee a high standard and fulfilment of the Green Key criteria, rigorous documentation is needed and frequent audits are held on site.

What does Green key mean?

Establishments must fulfil Green Key criteria with 13 different management areas such as energy and water consumption, information, waster washing and cleaning. For example, green electricity and eco-labelled paper and cleaning products are used, waster is recycled in several fractions and the number of eco-labelled food products is increasing every year.

Green Key Sweden

The organization Green Key Sverige is responsible for the administration of Green Key in Sweden. Green Key has a Swedish steering group and jury who supports the label and develop the Green Key criteria. The members include Visita, Swedish Association of Eco-municipalities, Nature Best/International Eco-tourism Society, Swedish Association of Campsite Managers and Keep Sweden Tidy.

An International eco-label

The Green Key programme is operated internationally under the management of the Foundation for Environmental Education (FEE), a global organization committed to stimulating positive environmental change and sustainable development. Green Key is supported by United Nations Environmental Programme (UNEP) and World Tourism Organization (UNWTO). Today, more than 2500 hotels and other establishments in over 50 countries are awarded with Green Key.
