Founded in the late 18th century, the Tretyakov State Gallery houses the largest collection of Russian art dating from the 11th to the 17th century. Admire masterpieces, sculptures and applied arts alongside “Golden Age” paintings and 20th century portraits and graphic art.

THE PUSHKIN MUSEUM OF FINE ARTS

Home to over half a million works of art from across Europe, the museum’s collection includes paintings, sculptures, graphic art, numismatic items, photography and archaeological finds. The Pushkin also features works by celebrated artists such as Picasso, Matisse and Van Gogh.
